BASKETBALL:

Year-round leagues need referees, statisticians, scorekeepers & coaches
Fall season begins November 30, 2010 through February 10, 2011, with breaks during holiday.

BACK TALK:

This Communities That Care (CTC) program meets every other Tuesday from 4pm-5pm and focuses on anti-drug & anti-alcohol activities with middle school and high students.

CHESS CLUB:

Year-round program with emphasis on teaching chess skills meets on Wednesday Nights, 6pm-8pm, with the potential of expanding to include tournaments, possibly on weekends.

FAMILY NIGHTS:

Activities for elementary-aged students and their families are planned monthly, usually on Friday, from October through April, 6:30pm-8pm. Examples of past Family Nights include Bingo Night, Board Game Night, Magician/Comedian Night, and Science Night.

FITNESS CENTER:

Assist with setup, breakdown and helping participants on Thursdays at 6pm at Eisenhower Middle School during the fall and winter.
